Come and join our Baby Program

Do you have any questions about your baby's learning and development?

The Hunter Prelude Baby Program offers:

- Supports that are centred around your baby and your family.
- Information and support to understand babies' growth and development.
- A committed team with knowledge, experience and skills to work with you and your baby, in your home and in the community.
- Opportunities to build a support network.
- Work collaboratively with external services eg. Health, Allied Health, early childhood and family services.

What happens in the Baby Program?

- We meet with you and discuss your concerns and goals for your child and how we can work together to achieve these goals.



- This can be done at your home or in any other setting you identify.
- A play session is available at our Kurri Kurri or Singleton Centre for up to 2 hours, once per fortnight during school terms.
- A variety of play experiences and opportunities to explore the environment are provided to support and enhance your child's skills.

The Baby Program is staffed by a Transdisciplinary team that includes:

Early Childhood Educators:

- Promote play, learning and development.
- Promote social interaction and participation.
- Provide assessment.

Speech Pathologists (SP):

- Promote speech and communication.
- Help with eating and drinking difficulties.
- Provide assessment.

Occupational Therapists (OT):

- Assist with play, bathing, dressing and meal times.
- Adapt seating and positioning.
- Provide assessment.

Physiotherapists:

- Help with movement and motor development, such as rolling, sitting, walking and climbing.
- Provide assessment.

Psychologist:

- Consultative clinics.
- Provide assessment.
