Services under these 2 programs can be provided

- In your home or community - to support your child develop skills to participate in your everyday activities.
- In your child's Early Childhood Education Setting or at School – to work together with teaching staff who work with your child to develop strategies to support your child's learning and development.
- At one of the Hunter Prelude centres in Kurri Kurri or Singleton to support your child and family.

What we can provide

- Advice, support and individualised strategies to parents, teaching staff and other people involved with your child to support everyday routines and transitions.
- Assessments for Speech Pathology and support to Promote your child's speech, language, communication and literacy skills.
- Assessments for sensory processing difficulties and support to develop hand skills, use equipment and tools with increased skill, such as drawing and using scissors.
- Assist with play and friendships, bathing, dressing, meal times, feeding, and toileting skills.
- Adapt seating, positioning and equipment.
- Advice and support to facilitate transition to Early Childhood Education and Care Settings or School.
- Support to purchase resources for your child through FaHCSIA funding.
