Hunter Prelude is registered to provide services for your child under the NDIS. In this brochure we will tell you a little bit about the NDIS and how Hunter Prelude can help you.

What is the NDIS?

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is a new way for people with disability to access early intervention and other supports.

How do I access NDIS funding?

Once your child's eligibility is confirmed, You and your child meet with a 'planner' from the National Disability Insurance Agency to discuss your hopes (known as 'goals and aspirations') for your child and to form a 'plan' outlining the supports your child will need to work towards them.

You and the planner will then work together to identify what current and future supports will be needed.

This part of the plan, the 'Statement of Participant's



Supports' sets out the supports that will be provided or funded by the NDIS and includes a budget for your child.

We are a committed team with diverse skills, training and experience in early childhood, development and disability.

Our team consists of:

Early Childhood Educators:

- Promote play and learning
- Promote social interaction and participation
- Provide assessment

Speech Pathologists (SP):

- Promote speech and communication
- Help with eating and drinking difficulties
- Provide assessment

Occupational Therapists (OT):

- Assist with play, bathing, dressing and meal times
- Adapt seating and positioning
- Provide assessment

Physiotherapists:

- Help with movement and motor development
- Provide assessment

Psychologist:

- Provide information and Advice
- Provide assessments

A key worker from this team will work closely with your family.

Hunter Prelude can work with you throughout your planning process and once you get your package.
